Wayne County School District Parental Involvement/Title I Complaints/Concerns

A complaint/concern is a <u>signed</u>, <u>written</u> statement that includes allegations or concerns applicable to the Title I Educational Program (LEA Level) and information that supports the complaint/concern. Any parent, teacher, or other concerned individual(s) or organization may file a complaint/concern.

Procedures:

- 1. Signed written complaints/concerns may be given to the local school supervising principal and/or filed at the Office of the Superintendent.
- 2. A signature of the individual submitting the complaint/concern is required for all filings.
- If the written complaint/concern is turned in to the local school supervising principal, then it will be delivered to the Wayne County School District Superintendent's Office by the principal or his/her designee.
- 4. Upon receipt of the written complaint, the Federal Programs Director and a District Supervisor will investigate the complaint in a timely manner consulting with the Wayne County School District Superintendent if necessary.
- 5. Within a timely manner, a resolution and written decision acknowledging receipt of the complaint/concern will be rendered by the Wayne County School District.
